KOTA BARU: Only 70 per cent of the 6,000 Kelantan government servants are allowed to work at office during the Conditional Movement Control Order.

The directive, effective yesterday, was issued by deputy Kelantan state secretary (management)

civil servants to work from home

Datuk Tengku Azmi Tengku Jaafar.

In a circular that was distributed to all state government heads of department, Tengku Azmi said heads of department must ensure the services provided by the departments were not affected by the new directive.

“Heads of department must ensure the rest of their workers are working from home during office hours.

“They (workers) must also ensure that they are contactable and be prepared if their employers direct them to return to the office or to


travel anywhere.”

He said employers must ensure the safety of those working in the office.

“They must adhere to the Covid-19 standard operating procedures at all times in the office.”

Meanwhile, state Local Government, Health and Housing Committee chairman Dr Izani Husin said the new directive was agreed upon by all departments under the state government.

“They have agreed to follow the order for the safety of all workers.”
