

NEW NORMS FOR WORKERS



For CMCO areas in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya and Sabah, a WORK FROM HOME ORDER has been issued effective yesterday.



Those working from office must have a travel approval letter from employers.



Covid-19 swab tests **ENCOURAGED** for those from red zones going to the office. It is **COMPULSORY** for foreign workers in the construction and security sectors.

The government will extend Covid-19 screening from today to all Social Security Organisation (Socso) contributors in CMCO areas, said Human Resources Minister Datuk Seri M. Saravanan

- Employers can conduct Covid-19 screenings for their employees for free through an appointment with a service panel appointed by Socso.
- The screenings can be conducted at clinics, labs or the workplace.
- Employers can also opt for the Prihatin Screening Subsidy. The employer must bear the screening cost first, and later claim the subsidy payment by submitting the claim form and the payment receipt through <https://psp.perkeso.gov.my> portal.



Employers must set a suitable work-from-home guideline that fulfils the company's needs.



Staff under essential and informal sectors allowed to work as usual.



RESPONSIBILITIES OF EMPLOYERS



Conduct health screening at the entrance



Ensure check-in using MySejahtera



Disinfect surfaces that are often touched



Provide hand-washing facilities or hand sanitiser



Provide an isolation room



Always keep toilets clean and provide soap



Ensure symptomatic employees receive immediate treatment



Advise employees to adopt preventive measures:

- Wear a face mask
- Wash hands frequently
- Practise correct coughing and sneezing etiquette

RESPONSIBILITIES OF EMPLOYEES



Practise correct coughing and sneezing etiquette



Wash hands frequently with soap and water or use hand sanitiser



Stay home if unwell



Keep windows open for better ventilation



Avoid sharing food



Always disinfect surfaces that are often touched

MIND YOUR PHYSICAL DISTANCE



Maintain at least a one-metre distance from colleagues



BUSINESSES UNDER CMCO



Restaurants, food trucks, hawkers, hawkery centres, eateries, sundry shops and convenience stores can operate from 6am to 10pm.



Dine-in allowed, with only two people per table at a time.



Daily markets can operate from 6am to 2pm.



Wholesale markets can operate from 6am to 12pm.



Farmers' markets can operate from 6am to 12pm.



Night markets can operate from 4pm to 10pm.



Petrol stations can operate from 6am to 10pm.



Petrol stations along highways can operate for 24 hours.
