# OKD AIMS TO EXPAND REGIONAL REACH

Firm offering biometric solutions that can cut processing time, human interaction

**D**RIVEN by his passion to introduce technological advancement solutions, Mohd Faiq Abu Sahid wants to broaden the reach of Orenda Kuantum Digital (OKD) Sdn Bhd in the region.

Faiq, 34, who is OKD director, said the company had been involved in information technology-related internal advisory work for Maju Holdings Sdn Bhd on its infrastructure projects since 2011.

"We want to be part of the government's efforts to expand adoption of Industrial Revolution 4.0 technologies among the private sector," he said.

"The time to digitalise is now. OKD offers holistic end-to-end biometric solutions and integrated automated border control systems.

"Some of the physical solutions we provide are eGates, security gates and kiosks," he said at OKD's solutions gallery in Bandar Tasik Selatan.

The gallery showcases security gates and a software system that is the result of its collaboration

with Cubox, a South Korean software development company.

Cubox is the company behind the security system being used at the Incheon International Airport.

Faiq said OKD offered solutions that would assist border control and security in terms of traffic flow, technology advancement at airport gates and chips for Immigration use.

OKD's solutions were not meant to control traffic flow but instead cut processing time and reduce human interaction, he said.

The biometric solutions could be applied to various areas including border security, aviation, access control, healthcare and public safety, he said, adding that they could be tailored to suit a client's needs.

Faiq said OKD collaborated with Cubox as both countries had the same geographical landscape, which meant the same border security control solutions could work in Malaysia as well.

Faiq said OKD planned to set up a manufacturing plant with its partners in Malaysia.

"There is an untapped market in the country."
