

MCMC warns of scam featuring its name, logo

PUTRAJAYA: The public is advised to be on the alert for emails and other messages claiming to be from the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC), asking for personal details to enable them to claim cash prizes. MCMC said it did not issue any messages asking the public to claim cash prizes under a bonus scheme offered by a telecommunications company. It said according to the Cyber Intelligence Monitoring Network, victims received “MCMC” messages claiming that they had an unresolved transaction with Telekom Malaysia Berhad — a cash prize of RM270,000 under the TM Family Gift Bonus scheme.
