New state govt mobile app offers integrated services

THE Melaka government has launched the Melaka Pay mobile app, an integrated gateway to facilitate payment of various services offered by state government agencies.

Chief Minister Datuk Seri Sulaiman Md Ali said the mobile app was developed by the Information and Communication Technology Division of the Chief

Minister's Department.

He said first phase users could access 18 services from eight government agencies via the platform from April 1.

The agencies are the Land and Minerals Office, Melaka Tengah District and Land Office (PDT), Alor Gajah PDT, Melaka Historic City Council, Hang Tuah Jaya Municipal Council, Alor Gajah Municipal

Council and Tabung Amanah Pendidikan Melaka.

"The people can carry out checks or make payment for quit rent, parcel tax, assessment tax, compounds, heritage charge and education loan repayments.

"The Melaka Pay app can be downloaded for free from Google Play Store for Android users and App Store for iOS users,"

he said at the launch, adding that more agencies were expected to provide their services on the platform in the second phase.

Sulaiman said the development of the app was in line with the framework of the Melakaku Maju Jaya 2035 Strategic Plan under the fourth flagship, Digital Melaka.
