

PM to visit Cambodia and Thailand from Feb 23 – 26

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob will be making official visits to Cambodia and Thailand starting today till Saturday (Feb 26).

The visits are following invites from Cambodian Prime Minister Samdech Techco Hun Sen and Thailand's Prime Minister General Prayut Chan-o-cha to discuss regional as well as international issues of mutual interest.

Ismail Sabri will begin his two-day visit to Cambodia starting today, with a royal audience with the King of Cambodia, His Majesty Norodom Sihamoni.

He will then proceed to have a meeting with the Cambodian prime minister to discuss initiatives to strengthen Malaysia-Cambodia's long-standing relations, including post-Covid-19 Asean cooperation.

He is also scheduled to hold several separate meetings with the country's Senate President, Cambodia National Assembly president as well as "Keluarga Malaysia" during his visits.

Ismail Sabri will then proceed with his official visit to Thailand from Feb 24 till 26, where he will meet with Thailand's prime minister, to discuss the way forward in strengthening multi-faceted cooperation between the two countries.

The meeting will focus on economic cooperation, including post-Covid-19 matters, borders reopening and key connectivity projects.

He is then scheduled to attend a separate session with the Malaysia-Thailand Chamber of Commerce (MTCC) and Keluarga Malaysia in Bangkok before returning home.
