"I am super excited and delighted to meet up with the PM," he told reporters after being honoured with a visit to Amanjaya Fire and Rescue Department fire station here today.

The elder of two children, who appeared in full firefighter uniform, arrived at the fire station in a fire engine that later took part in a fire fighting demonstration.
