

## PM directs Nadma, Health Ministry to ensure comfort, safety of flood victims

KUALA LUMPUR: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob has instructed the National Disaster Management Agency (Nadma) to ensure sufficient supply of food at flood evacuation centres activated in Kelantan and Terengganu.

He has also directed the Health Ministry to assist with Covid-19 prevention measures to curb the spread of the virus at the relief centres.

"To all flood evacuees, please follow the safety measures and procedures and evacuate to the relief centres or higher ground that are safe for you and your family," said Ismail Sabri in a statement on his official Facebook page today.

He added that since yesterday, Nadma had deployed rescuers from several departments and agencies for the evacuation operation of people affected by floods in the two states.

Among the departments and agencies involved in the operation include the Fire and Rescue Department, police, Armed Forces and Civil Defence Force.

"Rescuers from the Fire and Rescue Department are on the ground to ensure the evacuation process involving people affected by the floods proceeds smoothly.

"The Armed Forces through the Eighth Infantry Brigade have also been deployed to help the victims in both states.

"Many people who are affected by the floods have been rescued and relocated to safer locations," he said.
