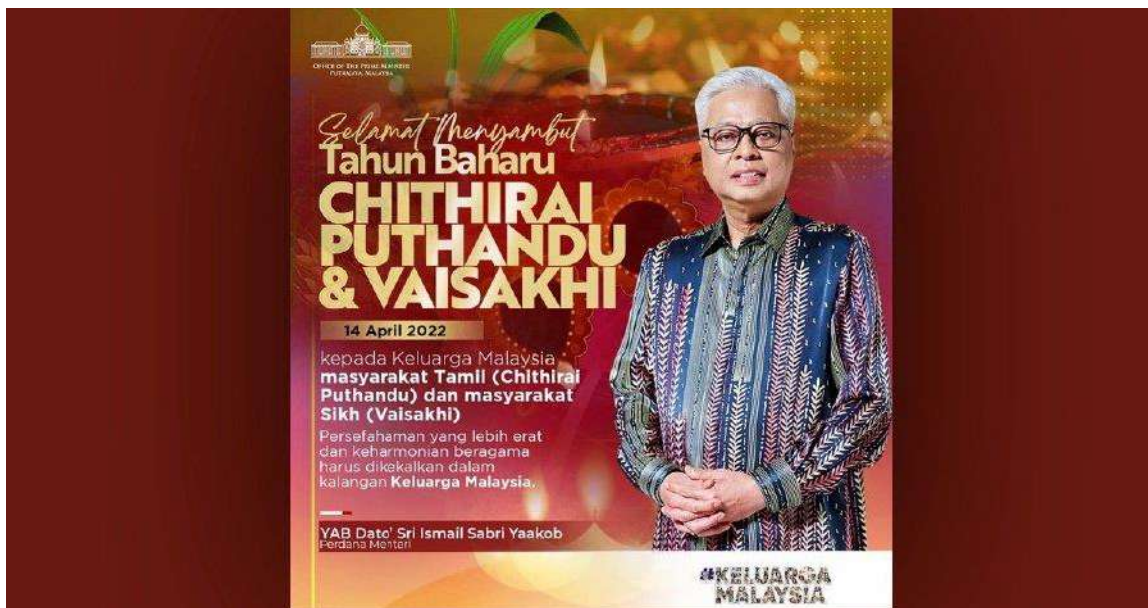


PM wishes Happy New Year to Tamil and Sikh communities
