

Ali Hamsa to be buried in Putrajaya

PUTRAJAYA: Former chief secretary to the government Tan Sri Dr Ali Hamsa will be laid to rest at a Muslim cemetery in Presint 20 here on Monday.

According to a statement by the Prime Minister's Department, prayers for Ali would be performed at the Tuanku Mizan Zainal Abidin Mosque in Presint 3 at about 10am.

The department said the body of the 13th chief secretary to the government is expected to arrive at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) in Sepang at about 3am before being taken to the mosque.

"The people can pay their last respect to Ali at the Sheikh Daud Al-Fathoni Hall starting 8am until 9.45am before prayers for him begins.

"His body would later be taken to the Muslim cemetery, where he is expected to be laid to rest at 10.15am," the statement said.

Ali died at a hospital in Dublin, Ireland, on April 21.

He was born in Kluang, Johor on Aug 29, 1955.
