



KUALA LUMPUR: The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah congratulated the country's wushu exponents Tan Zhi Yan and Clement Ting Su Wei for winning gold at the 31st SEA Games in Hanoi, Vietnam on Friday (May 13).

Through a posting on Istana Negara official Facebook, the Raja Permaisuri Agong Tunku Hajah Azizah Aminah Maimunah Iskandariah also congratulated the national athletes on their victory.

Ting, 24, emerged champion in the men's changquan event after scoring 9.70 points, while Zhi Yan, 22, triumphed in the men's taijiquan event with 9.71 points.
