KUALA LUMPUR: Datuk Rodzi Md Saad has been appointed as the Malaysian Administrative Modernisation and Management Planning Unit (Mampu) director-general, effective Tuesday (May 30).

Mampu, in a statement, said Rodzi, 59, replaces Datuk Seri Dr Yusof Ismail.
