

Cabinet members honour Salahuddin

KUALA LUMPUR: Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said the country lost a great leader in Datuk Seri Salahuddin Ayub.

Zahid said the domestic trade and cost of living minister, who died at the Sultanah Bahiyah Hospital this evening, was a humble person and that the latter was committed towards his work.

"Until his final breath, he (Salahuddin) was concerned about the welfare of the people and he continued to look for ways to champion the wellbeing of the rakyat.

"The country lost a great leader.

"Let us pray that his soul received all the blessings from Allah and that his family remain strong going through such a difficult time," said Zahid in a posting on his Facebook account.

In a separate Facebook posting, Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Fadillah Yusof extended his condolences to the family of Salahuddin.

"May Allah blesses his soul, may he be placed among the faithful," Fadillah said.

Health Minister Dr Zaliha Mustafa said Malaysia lost a people-centric leader in Salahuddin.

"I received the sad news of the passing of my friend, Datuk Seri Salahuddin Ayub, immediately after returning from paying a visit to his family at the Sultanah Bahiyah Hospital in Alor Star, Kedah.
